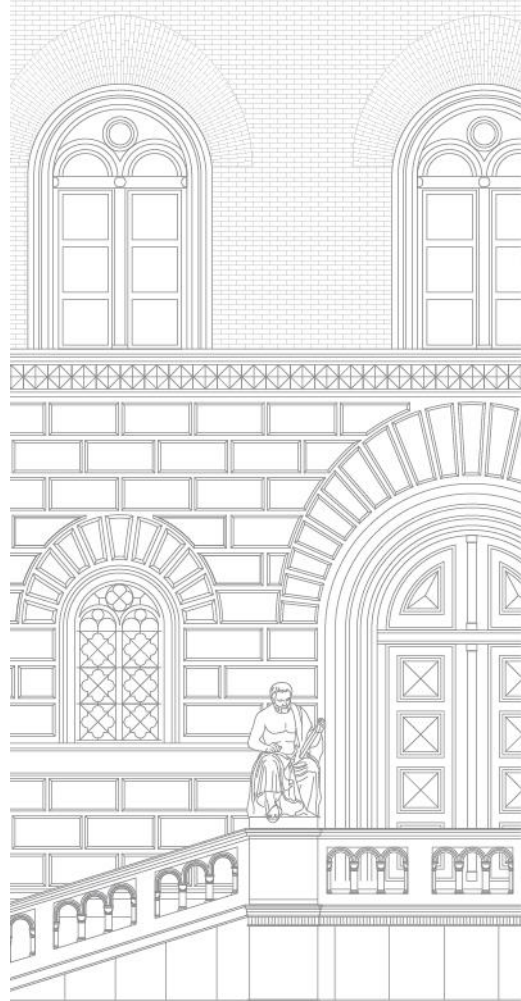

Some facts of the Bavarian State Library

- founded in 1558
- 11.1 million volumes
- yearly increase by 117.000 volumes
- 787 employees
- total expenses: 58 million €
- 8 million € third-party funds from 46 projects



Some facts of the Bavarian State Library

- 2.9 million digitized works
- 376 million image files
- yearly downloads of digitized works: 805.000
- data volume in long-term archive: 1.15 PB
- yearly increase in long-term archive: 1.34 TB



The Music Department of the Bavarian State Library

- 482,000 music prints
- 77,700 music manuscripts
- 355 bequests
- 100,600 sound carriers
- 172,500 books on music



Digitization in the Bavarian State Library

Four different ways to finance the digitization:

- third-party funds
- digitization on demand
- digitization with BSB-funds
- public-privat-partnership with Google

- books on music (monographs)
- music journals
- music prints
- music manuscripts
- libretti
